“Ton Plus Four” Run - Information Sheet

The “Ton Plus Four” Run, to be held on Saturday 21 November 2026, will be approximately 150 kilometres on sealed roads mostly through country areas with some hills. Check-in (optional breakfast) time will be from 8:00am at Cootamundra Showground with the start times from 9:30am for older bikes and others shortly afterwards.

The run will have vested officials approximately 100 metres before each corner. Back up trailers will follow the ride and if requested will carry riders’ reserve fuel containers.

There will be a comfort stop at Dirnaseer Hall (approx 10:30), with complimentary cool drinks. Older bikes to depart around 11:00, followed by others.

Lunch will be in Cootamundra, at the Rugby Club (Country Club / Bassingthwaite) Oval, from approximately 12:00 noon. Departure for final loop of Run and return trip to Coota Showground expected to be around 1:30pm.

In the case of a breakdown, it is the responsibility of the rider to secure their bike on a trailer. Back up vehicles will assist where possible, however due to time constraints the backup vehicle will have 10 minutes to get the stranded motorcycle underway. Failing that, the entrant can either load their motorcycle on the backup trailer or make their own transportation arrangements. **No bike/rider will be left behind !**

Dinner on Saturday evening will be at the Cootamundra Ex-Services Club starting at 7:00pm with the bar opening at 6:30pm. A courtesy bus will be available.

There will be a Sunday morning social run (to Jugiong), departing from the Ex-Services Club car park at 9:30. **This run will be open to all motorcycles of all ages.**
